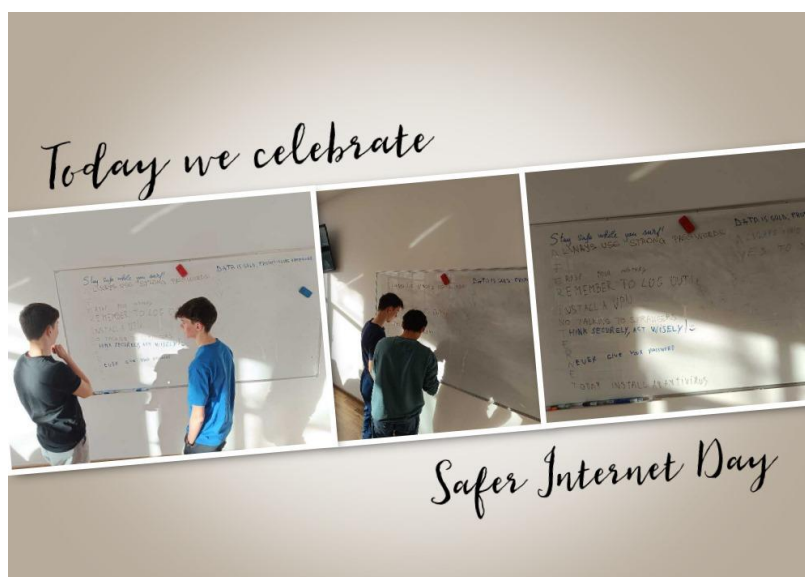


Proiect eTwinning *BEWARE*
